


National PTA Committees / Letter of Interest

Selena Sloan Butler of Atlanta Georgia was the founder and first president of the National Congress of Colored Parents and Teachers Association (NCCPT). Local PTA/PTSA Unit Nominating Committee

Did you know this is what is in your bylaws about your nominating committee?

*There shall be a nominating committee composed of three (3) members who shall be elected by this local PTA/PTSA unit at a regular general membership at least two (2) months prior to the election of officers. The committee shall elect its own chair.

*The nominating committee shall nominate an eligible person for each office to be filled and report its nominees at a general membership meeting prior to the election meeting.

*Additional nominations may be made from the floor at the election meeting. Only those paid members who have given their consent to serve, if elected, shall be nominated for, or elected to an office.
